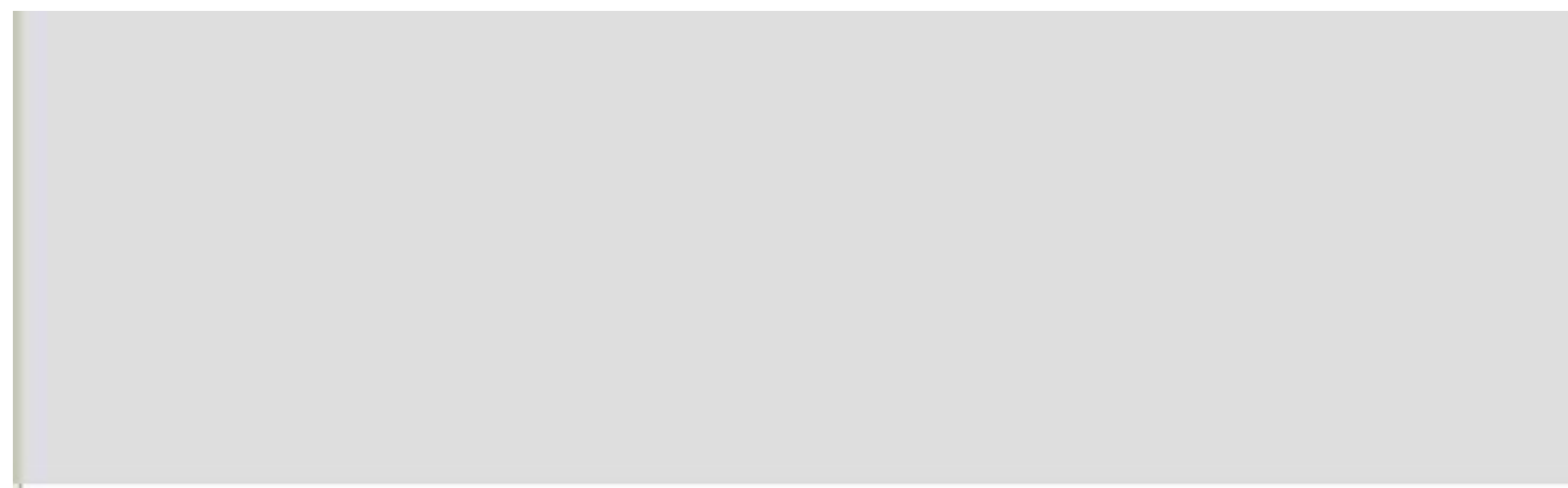

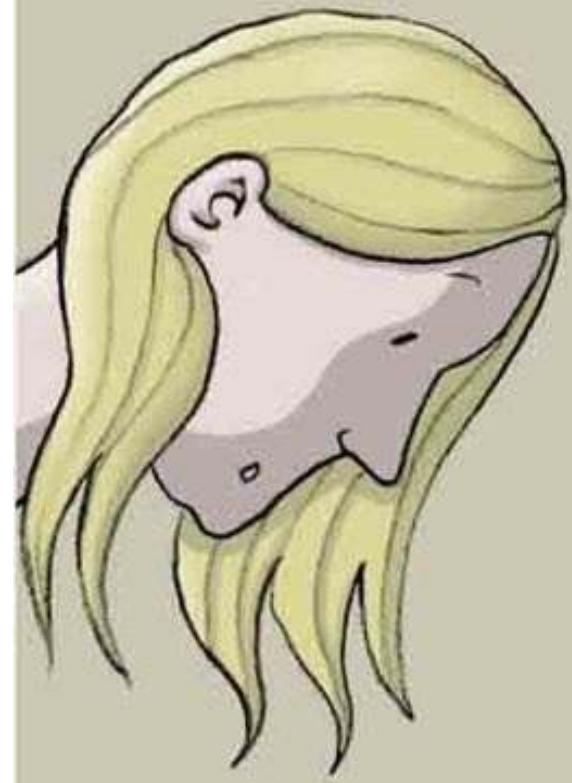
They also have a better understanding of the sufferer, their situation and circumstances.

We hope this book will shed some light into what your loved one's Black Dog illness, not a life sentence. It does pass.

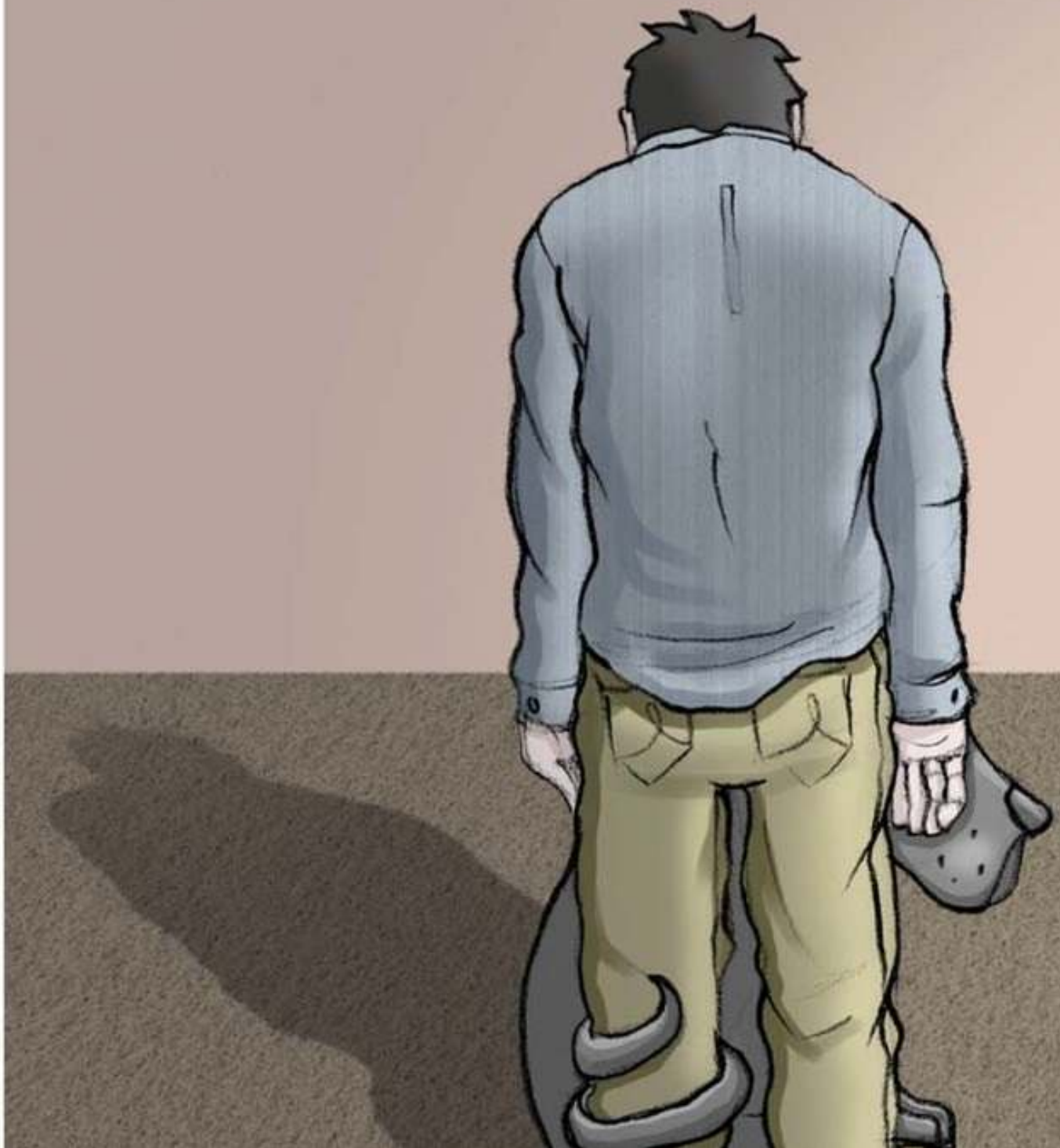

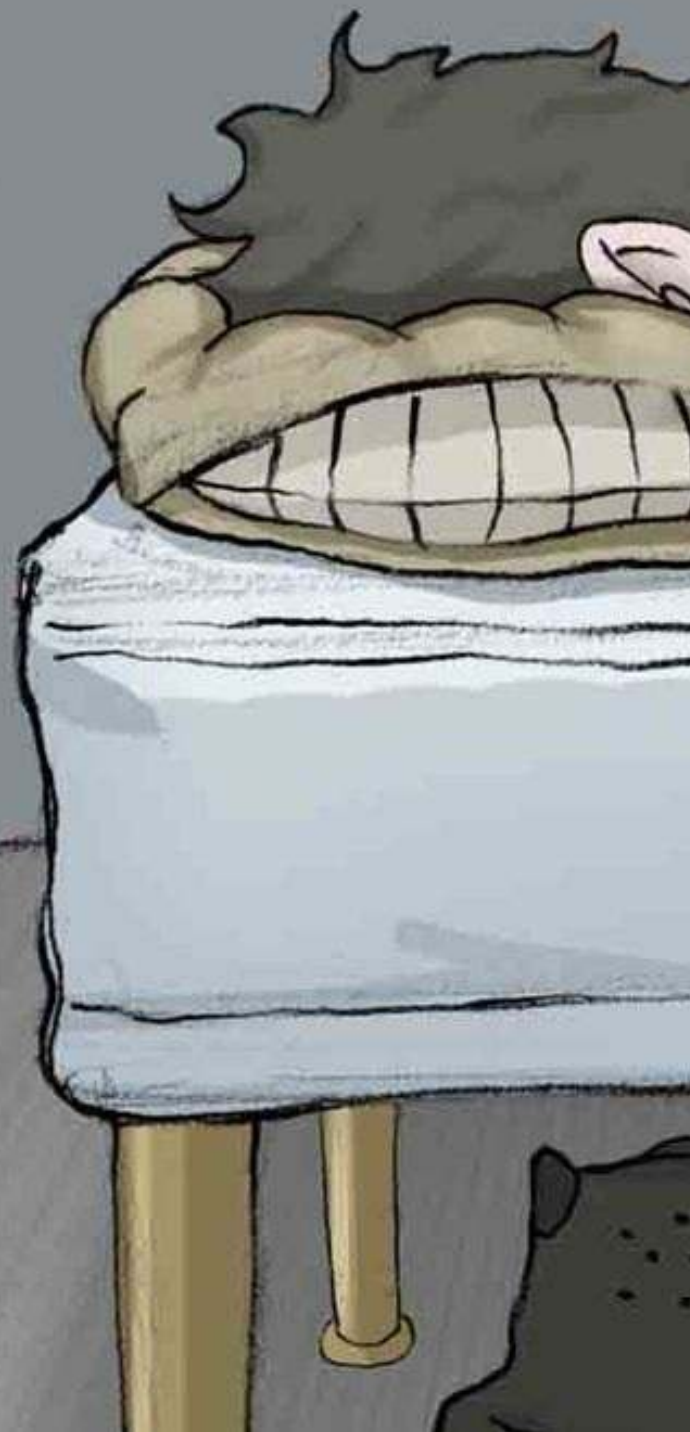


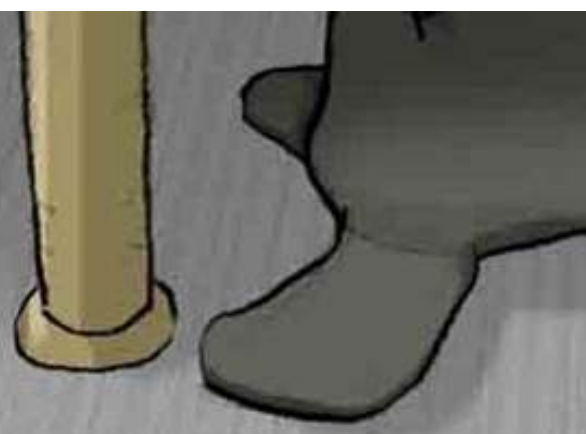
